






SECOND WORKSHOP, FIRST IDEAS FOR THE DISCUSSION, JANUARY 2014









MAPPING MAKENI CITY

THIRD WORKSHOP, TOWARDS IMPLEMENTING ACTIONS, JANUARY 2016

- **1. APPROACH.** Workshop with theoretical sessions (TS), practices (PS) and fieldwork (FW), for working about planning Makeni in **two levels: City Scale and Neighbourhood Scale.**
- 2. GOALS. Raising awareness, disseminating, involving stakeholders, training and working together with the main urban actors of Makeni, in decision-making for the development of the Strategic Plan of Makeni. Discussion about the new proposals presented by CEU San Pablo University

3. PARTICIPANTS. Mainly technicians and decision makers in Makeni: Landowners, Staff and students of the University of Makeni, Makeni City Council, Bombali District, Northern Province, Ministry of Lands, Country Planning and Environment, other administrative areas, SALWACO (water and sanitation in SL), roads authorities, Paramount Chief and other relevant people in the city management.

PLANNING THE AFRICAN CITY THE CASE OF MAKENI, SIERRA LEONE

The important recent urban sprawl of the most disadvantaged contexts is the biggest challenge facing the global habitabity. According to UNN-Habitat, in aspo will be in sub-Saharan Africa about 762, o million new urban dwellers (which is equivalent to the total of the current European population). The habibability deficit, the scarce economic resources, the lack of skilled personnel, a weak regulatory framework, the attachment to the traditions and primary activities, are just some factors that increase the dificulties.

Makeni, Sierra Leone, is a paradigmatic city of such realities. With an estimated 120,000 people in recent years is evident the urban expansion beyond the limits of the city through a model of dispersed occupation. The challenge of urban expansion in developing countries is therefore the leitmotif of this activity, aimed at
